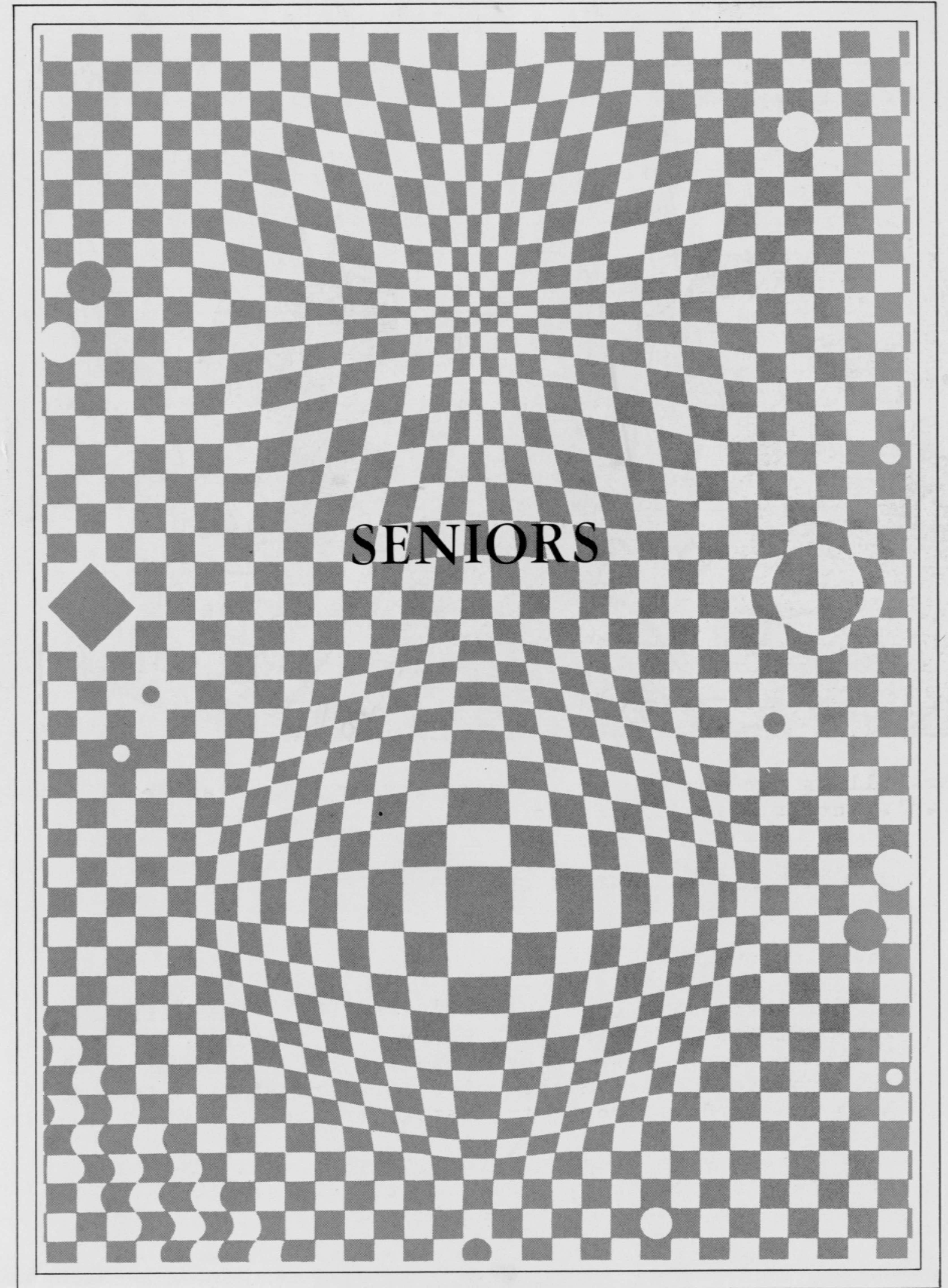
Dear Seniors,

Our hearts were saddened at the thought that we would never again be drawn together in the same manner we have known during the past four years. It is impossible to list all the events that have taken place, but no one could forget the help and guidance given to us by our teachers and sponsors, in preparing us for the future. The Seniors of 1969 hope The Senior Class of 1970 will have as many fond memories of M. V. H. S. as we. FAREWELL.
