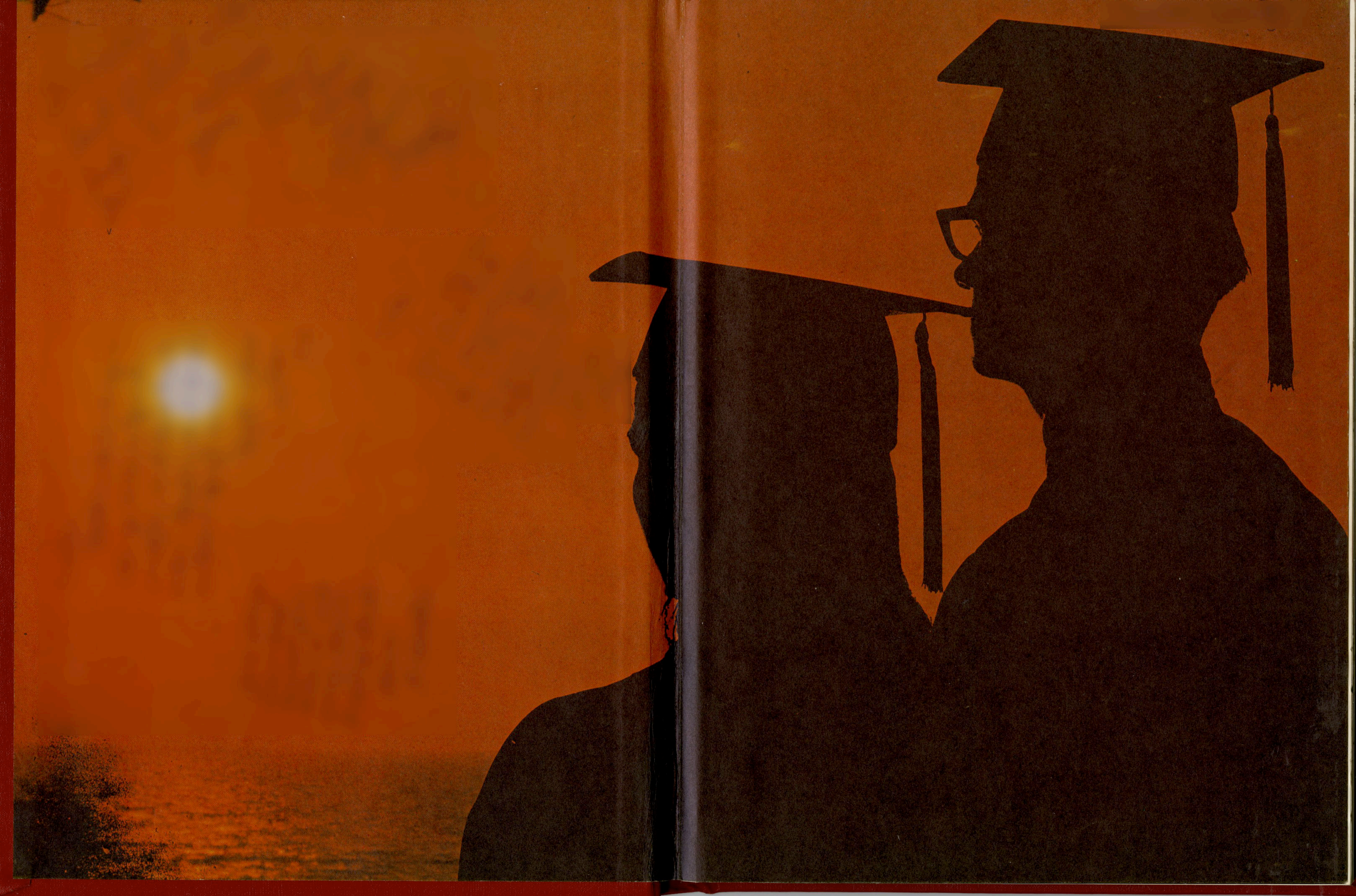

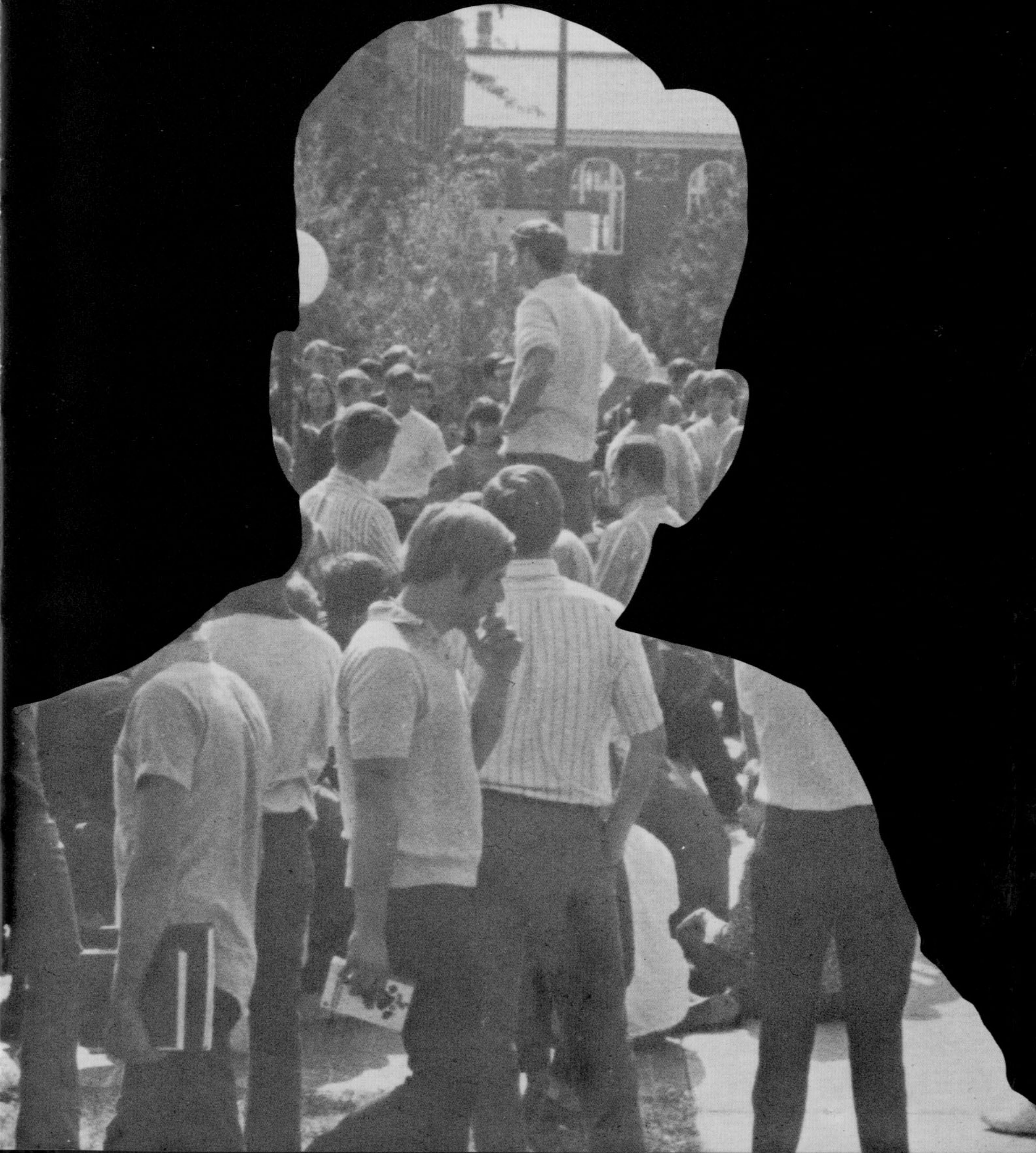
## Dedication
