## Class of '77 Dedicates Yearbook

We the Senior Class of 1977 wish to dedicate the "Reflections '77" to Mrs. Catherine Graves, who greatly deserves this great honor.



You've come a long way teacher.

First, in 1937, there was a one room frame school house, heated by a pot-bellied coal stove. The enrollment was 23 boys and girls in all eight grades from the hills and hollows of Ceitz Branch on Skaggs Creek. School was a term of seven months. The teacher had an A.A. in Elementary Education from Cumberland College and she thought children could be taught according to the book.

Experience changed that idea.

As the years went on, other one-room schools followed. Then there was a two-room school where this teacher taught the lower grades. Next there was a three-room school where she was the head teacher.

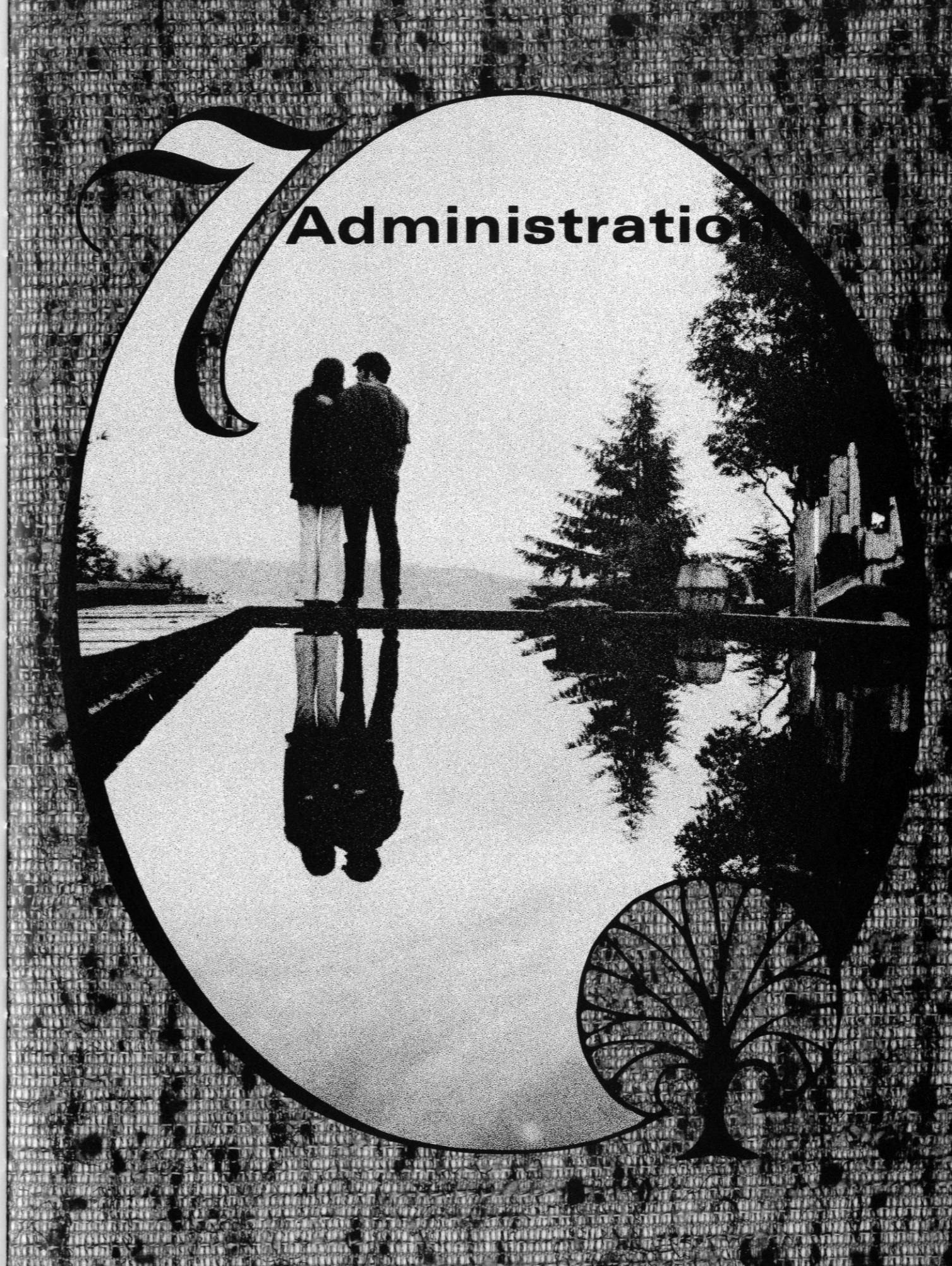
Finally, in 1955, she made the decision to to secondary teaching and taught general science and math at the Brodhead school. Then there was an opening in the English department and she has been in the English field ever since. She has taught all four grades 9-12. In 1973 she moved to the new consolidated R.C.H.S. Presently in 1976-77, she is with 42 other teachers in a 60-room brick, all electric building with 901 boys and girls from all over the county and school is a 9¼ month term.

Since beginning her career, the teacher has graduated from Eastern University and did graduate work at University of Kentucky. During her 34 years of teaching she has had students from all over the county and now in her classes some of the students are offspring of students in her first school.

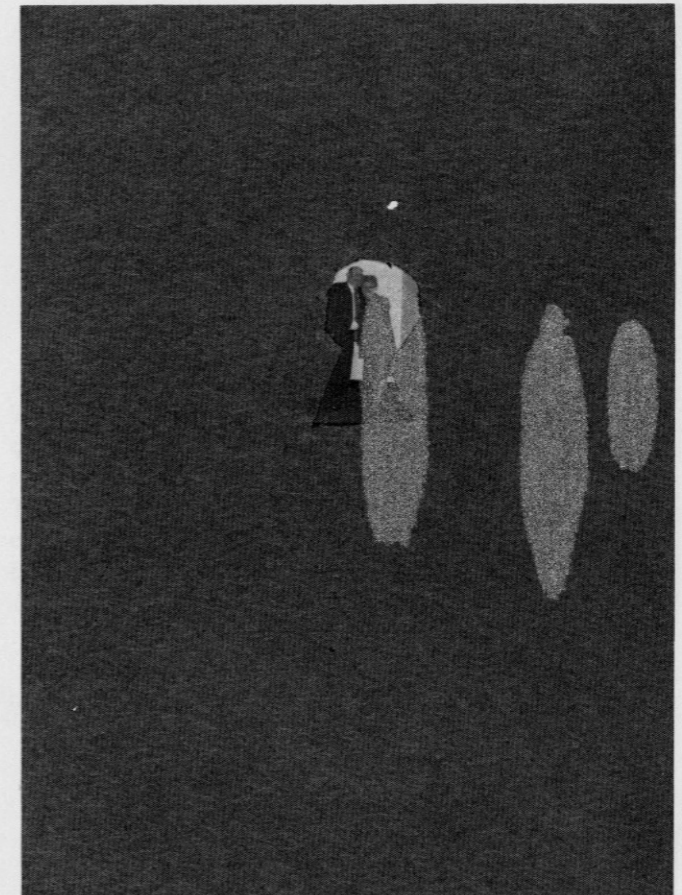
## Principal

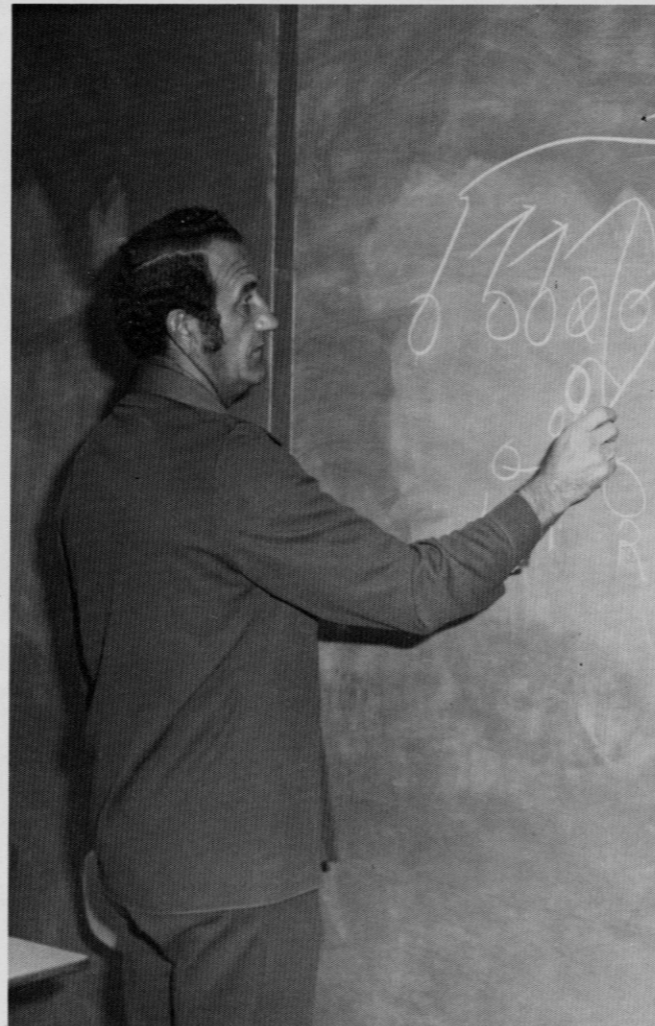
