Reflections '78 Is Dedicated to Mr. Bob Hendrickson

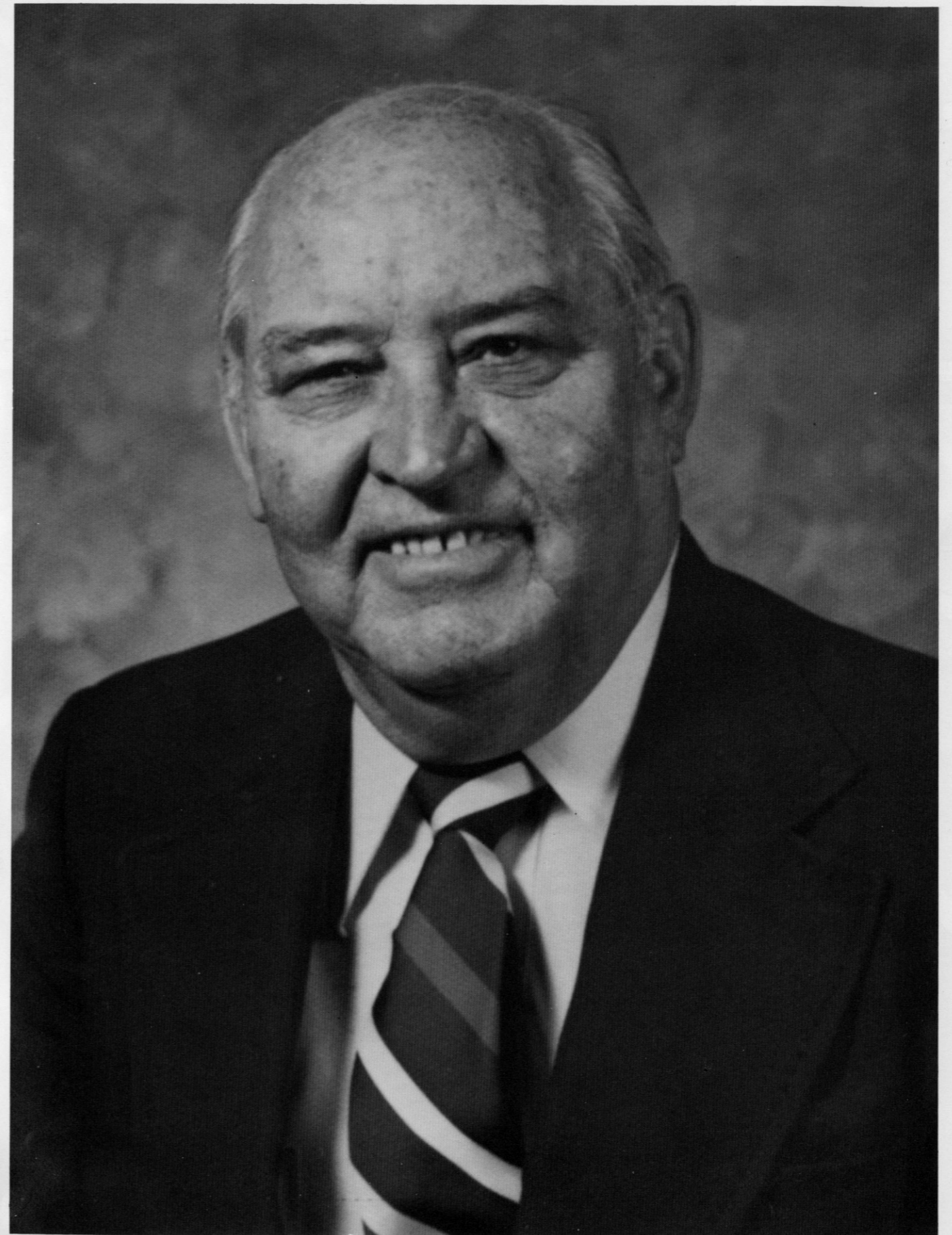

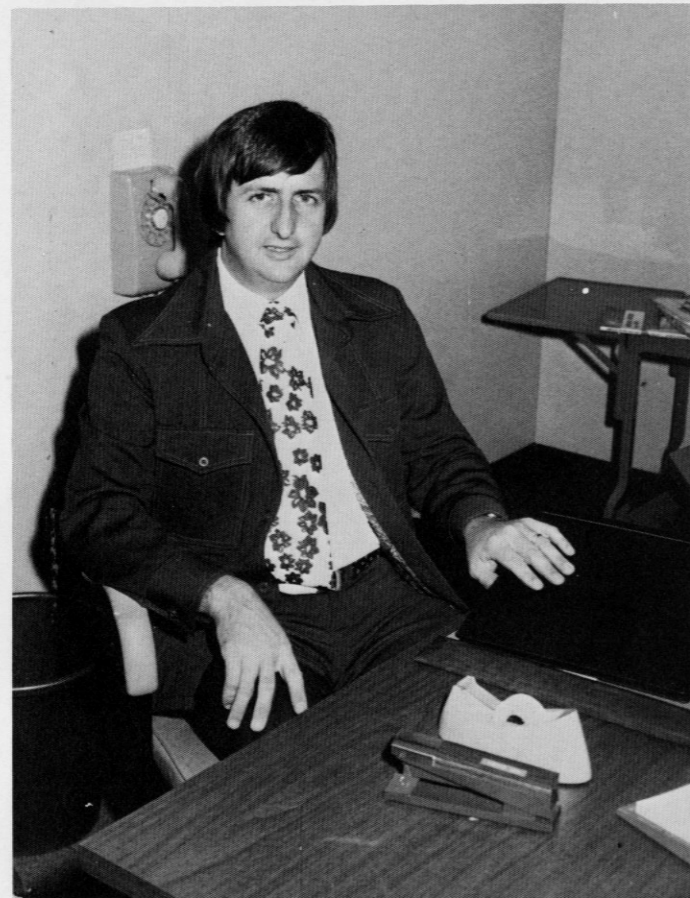
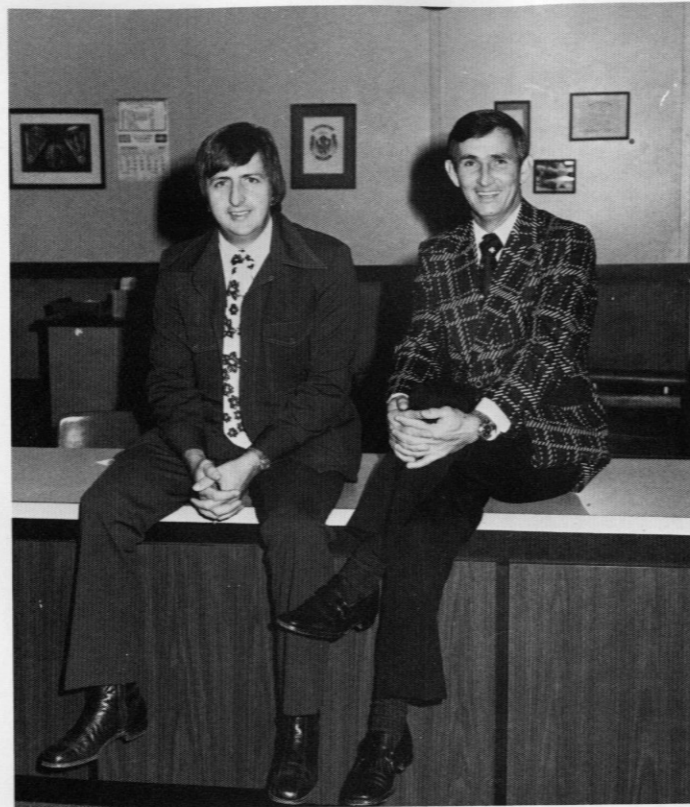
Assistant Principals

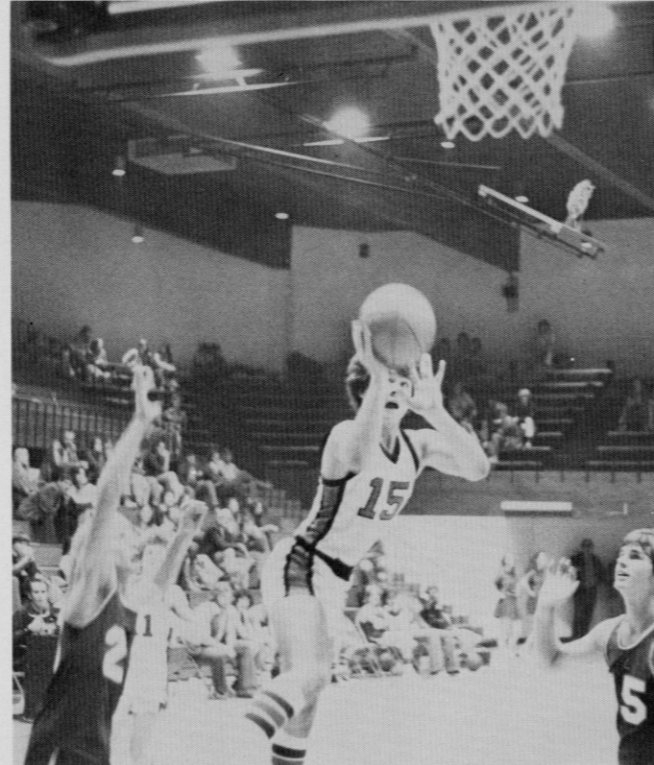
