


## "Reflections" Is Dedicated




#### "Everyone Loves Mr. Riddle"






# Principals Keep the School Going

What the students were familiar with as the library is. now called the instructional media center because it offers a wider range of materials such as various audio-visual aids. These materials help both teachers and students with their research.




